Module Descriptors

English Language

This subject aims to enable students to communicate effectively in English. At the end of the course, students are expected to be able to listen, read, write and speak to meet general living needs; and they are expected to understand and use internationally acceptable English grammar and vocabulary accurately and appropriately by speaking and writing for educational purposes

Mother Tongue Language

This subject aims to enable students to communicate effectively in their mother tongue. At the end of the course, students are expected to be able to listen, read, write and speak to meet general living needs; and they are expected to speak, write and make presentations in their mother tongue.

Elementary Mathematics

The syllabus is intended to provide students with the fundamental mathematical knowledge necessary for continuous learning and for applications in the real world. The study aims to develop mathematical thinking, problem solving skills, use connections among mathematical ideas and develop the abilities to reason logically.

Principles of Accounts

The syllabus aims to develop an understanding of the principles and concepts of accounting and their applications in a variety of business situations. Candidates will acquire basic knowledge in double entry and develop the ability to prepare, present, analyze and interpret financial statements

Geography

This subject aims to let student acquire knowledge of the characteristics and distribution of physical and human phenomena. They would also develop basic skills in acquiring, communicating and applying geographical knowledge. There would be awareness in the contrasting opportunities and constraints which people face in local, regional and global environments.

History

This subject aims to grasp the broad fundamental concepts common to all historical explanations and also a range of more specific ones. The students would be able to demonstrate understanding of the history of Southeast Asia from c.1870 to 1967, and understand international affairs and the forces that shaped twentieth-century world history

Combine Humanities (Social Studies, Geography/History)

Social Studies- Students would be able to understand issues that affect the socio-economic development, the governance and the future of Singapore. Thinking and processing skills would be developed for essential lifelong and independent learning

Geography Elective- Students are able to acquire knowledge of the characteristics and distribution of physical and human phenomena

History Elective- At the end of the course, candidates should be able to grasp the broad fundamental concepts common to all historical explanations and also a range of more specific ones. International affairs and the forces that shaped the twentieth-century world history would be studies as well.
